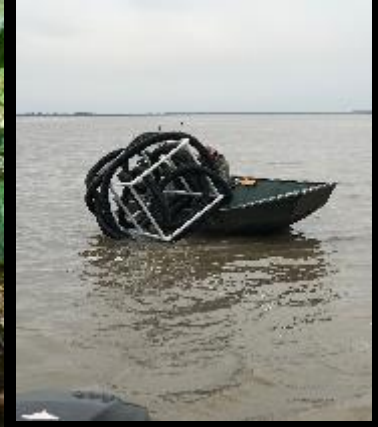


Why Fishing is Important

- Improves quality of life for communities
- Connects people to the outdoors = stewardship
- Gateway to other outdoor activities
- Economic benefit
- Sale of fishing licenses funds protection of fisheries resources

Funding Fish Habitat Enhancement and Angler Access

- Fishing faces challenges to
 - Degrading and/or lack of quality habitat
 - Deficiencies in angling access to quality fishing opportunities
- Programs to support *Freshwater Fish Habitat Enhancement* and *Shoreline/Bank Angler Access* have been limited



Habitat and Angler Access Program (HAAP)

- New competitive grant program
- Launches 6/15/2021
- Supported by fishing license sales
- Supports projects up to \$50K
 - Shoreline/Bank Access
 - Fish Habitat Enhancement and Restoration
- 100% Reimbursable



City of Early, Texas – Town Center Pond

- Over 3 acres
- Historically has supported fishing and Kid Fish events
- One of few community fishing ponds in the Big Country
- Prospective master plan places great importance on outdoor recreation
- Pond needs multiple improvements for viability as a fishing resource
- Great candidate site for HAAP

City of Early – Town Center Pond

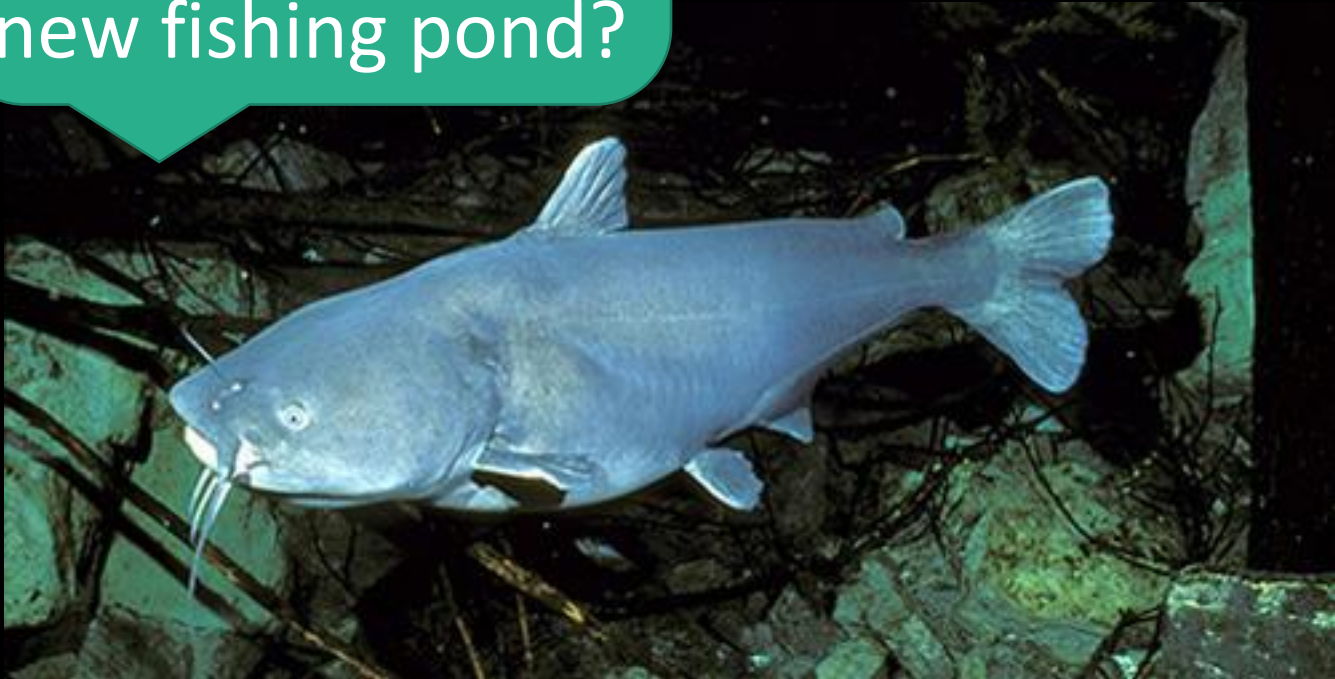


- TPWD has preliminarily approved \$45K internal funds for use of fish habitat improvements at Town Center pond site

City commitment is crucial

1. TPWD will need to draft a project proposal finalized by August 2021
2. City's completion of dredging and sealing of pond by early 2023
3. Habitat enhancement efforts must be completed by August 2023

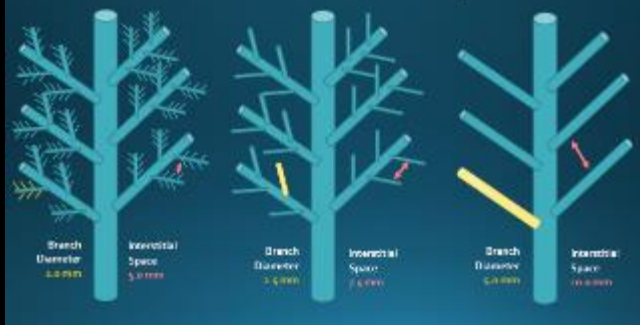

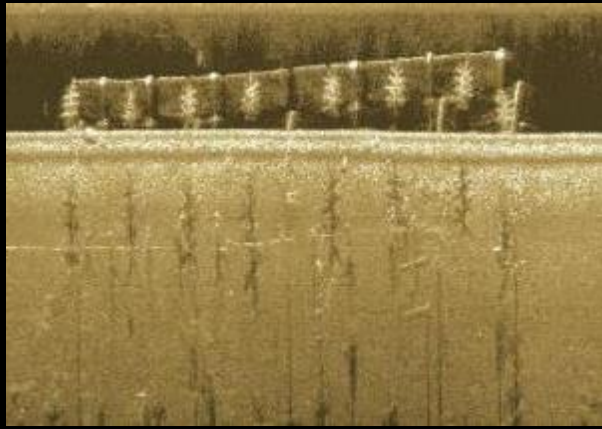

- HAAP Grant may offer additional opportunities for site improvements
 - Fishing piers w/ lighting
 - Fishing boardwalk
 - Additional habitat enhancements
- City would have to apply by August 20, 2021
- Awarded projects would also have a project completion deadline of August 31, 2023
