

Public Works Department

July– September 2023



The Public Works Department completed **253** work orders during the July through September quarter of 2023.

In addition to these work orders crews completed **114** brush pickups and **52** bulk item pick ups. During this time crews all assisted with different parts of the new Town Center Development.

During this Quarter crews completed the electrical wiring of the Town Center Lighting under the oversight of Larry McConn. Also progress continued on the sidewalks and batting cages for the town center.



The Public Works Department had the following specific projects:

- We began the long process of rehab on Autumn Dr. which included many changes to Water and Sewer on the street to compensate for the lowering street to help with water drainage.
- While having all crew busy we have still managed to shift when needed to deal with water leaks and other sewer issues that have come up.
- With receiving the much needed rain Crews shifted and assisted home owners affected in constructions area as the water run off got very heavy at times.
- During the delay at the Town Center Project due to the heavy rains, crews were able to install more of the updated black decorative stop and street signs continuing along Early Blvd.
