Public Works January – March 2024

In the months of January- March Sanitation added 9 new dumpsters had requests for 4 roll offs to be placed, along with regular routes being run. All the while completing 175 See Click Fix requests for brush and bulk pickups.

The water department had 229 total work orders completed. 55 of which were to connect water service, 41-meter replacements along with 25 transmitter replacements, as well as 22 leaks that were reported and repaired.

WWTP had some recent repairs on the pivots as well as routine maintenance on the hay equipment in order to be ready for this upcoming hay season.



Town Center Project is still in progress with the addition of new signs and maintenance on batting cages and up keep of the grass, as well as the Community Lake being stocked with a total of 250 bass ranging in size from 12” – 18” the Community Lake.



Our Water Department has been busy with a total of 229 workorders completed, with 22 reports and repairs of leaks as well as 55 water connections, 41-meter replacements as well as transmitter repairs. Water Department also purchased a new 2023 Dodge work truck, that was greatly needed.
