

This report is prepared to outline the progress and activity of the Early Fire Marshal's Office. This report starts January 1, 2021 and ends March 31, 2021. Approximately 176 reports were entered into the Emergency Reporting System and all reports were reviewed and exported to TXFIRS. Firefighters on duty performed their station duties during each shift without a hitch and were able to respond to calls. The Fire Marshal completed 9 hours of college courses towards an Associate's Degree in Fire Technology.
